#### FEE STRUCTURE:\* NEW- Register before the end of October to pay 2017 fees

##### FEES For 2018 are as follows:

Fees are \$ 3,240.00 (plus HST) for the 3 ½ week sessions.

Fees for the two week option are \$2,205.00 (plus HST)

Fees for the intro camp are \$1,045.00 for five days (plus HST) / \$1,920.00 for nine days (plus HST)

Fees may be paid in instalments but must be paid in full before campers arrive. The deadline for final payment of fees is May 1, 2018.

**REGISTRATION:** All parents, whether their boy has attended camp before or not, are required to fill out a registration, either online or by hard copy, and pay a deposit of \$300.00 per registration.

**Registering online** is quick and easy, and will simplify the process of sending in all your son(s) final information in the spring. You can register online by going to our web site ([www.camphurontario.com](http://www.camphurontario.com)) and clicking on “Register Online” in the Registration tab – this will then redirect you to our online registration site.

**If you registered your son(s) online last summer**, please login using your existing username and password and follow the directions to complete the registration for summer 2018.

**If you are using online registration for the first time**, you will need to “Create a new account” first. Once this is done, you can login and complete the registration process by following the instructions. **It is essential** that you record your user name, password, and security question, as you will need these to complete final information forms in the spring.

A registration fee of \$300.00 will be charged in order to complete the registration process. This deposit, less a \$150.00 administration fee, will be refunded if registration is cancelled before March 1<sup>st</sup>.

As Hurontario enjoyed a truly wonderful summer with amazing staff, energetic and lively campers, we are sure that again this fall the camp will fill quickly. **Register before the end of October to pay 2017 fees.** We recommend that registrations be sent to the office as soon as possible in order to confirm a place. We will email a confirmation upon receipt of registration and a deposit of \$300.00.

## **CANOE TRIP PROGRAM:**

The Massassauga Provincial Park, which is situated close to Hurontario's Loon Portage offers excellent, safe and interesting tripping for our younger campers. The Province charges a small daily fee of approximately \$11/day (plus HST) per camper for camping in the park. Further details of this fee will be included in our confirmation package .

Specialized trips in the Magnetewan, Restoule and Pickerel River Basins are available and, for the majority of our campers who are 12 - 13 years old, these trips will be a part of their summer program. **\*\*\*Please note: There is an additional charge for these advanced trips** to cover the high transportation costs. Trip forms with detailed cost & outlines of these trips will be mailed with the confirmation package.

### **ADVANCED CANOE TRIP PROGRAM:**

All boys who are 14 year of age and older will participate in a canoe trip in a remote but safe environment in the Chapleau Game Preserve where we own a well equipped northern outpost. This is a popular program and we are limited as to the number of campers who can take this opportunity to explore northern Ontario. Some campers who are 13 may also have the opportunity to trip in the Chapleau Game preserve if there is space. **Please note: there is an additional charge for these advanced trips** which will be outlined in our confirmation package.

### **WHITE WATER TRIPPING PROGRAM:**

For campers who are 15 or 16 years old, Hurontario offers the opportunity to experience the incredible fun of white water tripping. This program involves an excellent training course in the spring and a choice of five AMAZING river trips which vary from 10 days to 21 days in length. **Please note: there is an additional charge for these advanced trips** which will be outlined in the final confirmation package. In the spring, our leaders-in-training (15-16 years old) will have the opportunity to choose one of these river trips. Details of the white water program will be outlined in our confirmation package.

### **LEADERSHIP-IN-TRAINING PROGRAM:**

If a camper is 15 or turns 15 while at camp, he will be involved in our leadership-in-training program. This program, which has many facets, offers senior campers an opportunity to begin to work with younger campers, to organize camp activities, and to work on their own skills in preparation for becoming a staff member the next summer, provided the camper is successful in the leadership program. Please register your 15year old camper now so he can take advantage of this excellent program. It is very beneficial and teaches leadership skills for both city and camp life.
